ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO 2008-03  
FIFTH AMENDMENT

**IN RE: PRIVATE APPOINTED COUNSEL: EXTRAORDINARY RATES**

**WHEREAS**, Section 27.5304(12)(b), Florida Statutes, requires the chief judge or a single designee to hold an evidentiary hearing on motions to exceed the statutory limits in extraordinary and unusual cases; and

**WHEREAS**, by Administrative Order 2008-03, dated February 1, 2008, the clerk of court in the county in which any motion for extraordinary fees is filed is directed to immediately forward the motion to the chief judge for disposition, and

**WHEREAS**, for purposes of judicial economy it is appropriate to designate a judge in the criminal division to address these motions

**IT IS THEREFORE**

**ORDERED** that effective July 1, 2016:

1. Circuit Judge James C. Hankinson is hereby designated to hear all motions for extraordinary fees pursuant to Section 27.5304(12)(b), Florida Statutes.
2. The respective clerks of court shall immediately forward a copy of any such motion for extraordinary fees to Circuit Judge James C. Hankinson in his Tallahassee office.
3. Except as herein expressly amended, Administrative Order 2008-03 shall remain in full force and effect.
