1. **Nomination letter** | Letter introducing the nominee and describing the nominee's demonstrated professionalism and true dedication to the legal profession and the legal community through civil, community or legal service.
2. **Nominee's Resume** | Include the nominee's resume or professional biography.
3. **Supporting Materials** | Nominations may include no more than two additional letters of support.
